# Hawes Side Academy Core Learning Pathway

The core learning pathway provides parents, children and staff with a list of **some** essential basic skills that, when mastered, will help with progress through the curriculum.

## Year 1

### **Reading/Spelling/Grammar and Punctuation**

Sound out and blend words using phonic strategies, including those ending in 's', 'es', 'ing', 'ed', 'er' and 'est'

Learn to recite poetry

Retell a story including some of the main points

Spell the days of the week

Name the letters of the alphabet in order

Use the word 'and' to join sentences

Clearly read aloud own writing to someone else

Using capital letters for proper nouns

Begin to punctuate sentences using a capital letter, full stop, question mark or exclamation mark



### **Handwriting/Composition**

Sit correctly at a table holding a pencil comfortably and correctly

Form letters correctly (lower case in the correct direction starting and finishing in the right place)

Form capital letters and digits 0-9

Write sentences for different purposes (e.g. story, instructions, recount)



#### **Maths - Number**

Count, read and write numbers accurately up to at least 100, count in different multiples including one, twos, fives and tens

Add three 1 digit numbers together

Recall and use number bonds and related subtraction facts to 20

Recognise odd and even numbers to 100

Given a number, rapidly identify one more or one less to at least 30

Write in words numbers to 20
