Core Learning Pathway

The core learning pathway provides parents, children and staff with a list of **some** essential basic skills that, when mastered, will help with progress through the curriculum.

Year 3

Reading/Spelling/Grammar and Punctuation

Use time connectives and perfect tense

Understand how to place the possessive apostrophe in words with irregular plurals (e.g. the children's school)

Prepare poems and play scripts to read out loud

Spell words by analogy with other known words (e.g. light, fright and night)

Evaluate, edit and proof read their own writing

Use commas to mark clauses

Use the apostrophe for possession and plurals (e.g. the girl's book, the girls' books)

Use nouns, pronouns and conjunctions to establish cohesion within writing

Introduce speech punctuation

Use dictionaries for spelling



Handwriting/Composition

Continue to revise and practise correct letter formation regularly

To use joined handwriting throughout independent writing

Organise text into paragraphs to distinguish between different information, events or processes



Maths - Number

Read and write numbers accurately to at least 1000, in numbers and words

Add and subtract numbers with up to three digits using the column method (without carrying or borrowing)

Recognise the place value of each digit in a three digit number (hundreds, tens and units)

Rapidly recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20

Recall multiplication and division facts for the x2, x3, x4, x5, x8 and x10 tables

Tell time to nearest 1 minute including 24 hours and Roman numerals

Count in multiples of 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10, 50 and 100, give 10 or 100 more or less than any given number
