The core learning pathway provides parents, children and staff with a list of **some** essential basic skills that, when mastered, will help with progress through the curriculum.

## Year 4

### **Reading/Spelling/Grammar and Punctuation**

Correctly spell common homophones (e.g. to/two/too, peace/piece, their/they're/there)

Use and punctuate direct speech

Use commas after adverbials at the start of sentences (e.g. 'Finally, school opened')

Work out information that is not directly given in the text (e.g. such as working out a characters thoughts and motives from their actions)

Proof read own work checking for spelling and punctuation errors

Organise writing into paragraphs



### **Handwriting/Composition**

Write legibly, fluently and with increasing speed and personal style.

Ensure consistent and correct tense throughout a piece of writing

Identify the audience and purpose for writing and use the appropriate form



#### **Maths - Number**

Read and write numbers accurately to at least 10,000, in numbers and words

Add and subtract numbers using formal written method with up to 4-digits

Recognise the place value of each digit in a 4-digit number (thousands, hundreds, tens and units)

Round any number to the nearest 10 or 100 including decimals

Count in multiples of 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10, 50 and 100 from 0; give 10 or 100 more or less than any given number up to 100

Recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12x12

Find area/perimeter of compound shapes

Roman numerals to 100
