Everyone Matters, Everyone Succeeds

The core learning pathway provides parents, children and staff with a list of **some** essential basic skills that, when mastered, will help with progress through the curriculum.

Year 6

Reading/Spelling/Grammar and Punctuation

Use the passive voice for purpose (e.g. 'a visit was arranged by the school')

Plan, write to suit the audience and purpose

To revise language conventions and grammatical features of different types of text to convey and clarify meaning with their writing

To describe and evaluate the style of an individual text/writer

To secure the skills of skimming, scanning and efficient reading so that research is fast and effective

Support inference with evidence

Summarise key points from text and identify how language and structure contribute to the meaning

Use all punctuation (. , ! ? "" \ - () ...) correctly



Handwriting/Composition

Evaluate the effectiveness of their own and others' writing

Use organisational and presentational devices to structure text and guide the reader (e.g. headings, bullet points, underlining)



Maths - Number

Plot points in all 4 quadrants

Recall all times tables to x12 and inverse

Read, write, order and compare numbers to 10 million and determine the value of each digit

Add and subtract negative integers

Multiply numbers with at least four digits by a two digit number using long multiplication

Divide numbers by up to four digits by a two digit number using long division, and interpret the remainders as a whole number remainders, fractions, decimals or rounding

Perform mental calculations, including with mixed operations and larger numbers

Order and compare fractions

Long division

Use formula to find area/volume or shape and calculate area of triangles/parallelograms
