Dear Parents and Carers

Firstly, I would like to say how proud we are of our wonderful Foundation Stage children, they have just finished their first full week in school and it is amazing how quickly they have settled into school life and started to make new friendships. I am excited about the year ahead for them and will enjoy watching them flourish even more.

I would to thank all of our parents and carers, you have been so supportive of the academy on our return to school. As part of our preventative measures in relation to COVID-19, we have been in liaison with the local public health team to ensure we are doing everything we can to limit transmission of the virus. In our discussions they praised your continued support in being vigilant in keeping children off when displaying symptoms and using routine Lateral Flow Testing to identify any cases. By working together, we can continue to identify cases, limit the spread and keep our children in school to learn. With this in mind this weekend is a perfect opportunity to use Lateral Flow testing to our advantage and we ask that, if you are comfortable to do so, you test your child(ren) before returning to school on Monday reporting any positive cases in the usual way.

### **School Admissions – September 2022**

**Primary Applications** – If your child was born between **1st September 2017** and **31st August 2018**, you must apply for a Primary School Reception place for September 2022. (Applications are required for all children with a 4<sup>th</sup> birthday between 1st September 2021 and 31st August 2022). **Closing date for applications – 15<sup>th</sup> January 2022.**

**Secondary Applications** – If your child is in the final year of primary education (Year 6), you must apply for a Secondary School Year 7 place for September 2022. (Applications are required for all children who are in their final year at a primary school). **Closing date for applications – 31<sup>st</sup> October 2021.**

If you live in Blackpool (pay council tax to Blackpool) you need to apply for a school place on-line at: [www.blackpool.gov.uk/schooladmissions](http://www.blackpool.gov.uk/schooladmissions).

### Harvest - StreetLife

This year we will be supporting this worthwhile charity again. If you wish to send in donations of food and toiletry items (please see lists below) a collection box will be situated in the school office reception area.

#### Items StreetLife would appreciate are:

Food donations: Baked beans, biscuits, cakes, cereal, fruit juice, coffee, teabags, instant meals (e.g. pasta, soup, noodles, rice), long-life milk, puddings, rice, sauces, soft drinks, sugar, tinned fish, tinned fruit, tinned meats (e.g. corned beef, ham, sausages), tinned vegetables (e.g. carrots, peas and potatoes). StreetLife also accept items that will go towards meals for young people during sessions at their Day Centre, such as bread, eggs, cheese and fresh fruit.
