SCHOOL ADMISSIONS – SEPTEMBER 2019

PRIMARY APPLICATIONS

If your child was born between **1st September 2014** and **31st August 2015**, you must apply for a Primary School Reception place for September 2019. (Applications are required for all children with a 4th birthday between 1st September 2018 and 31st August 2019).

SECONDARY APPLICATIONS

If your child is in the final year of primary education (Year 6), you must apply for a Secondary School Year 7 place for September 2019. (Applications are required for all children who are in their final year at a primary school).

If you live in Blackpool (pay council tax to Blackpool) -

Applications received after the closing dates will be processed after all those which are received on time. If you apply late this may reduce your chances of an offer for one of your preferred schools.
