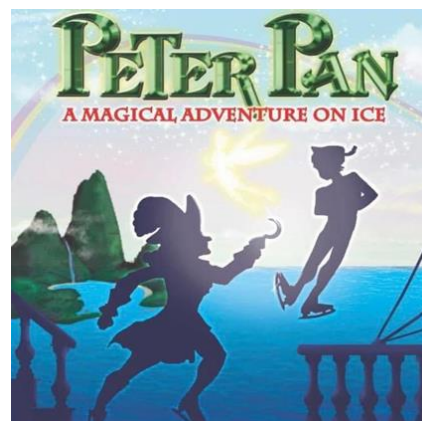
### **Peter Pan On Ice**

**Annual Flu Vaccination** – If you haven't already done so but would like your child to receive the annual flu vaccination, please follow this link below. The team will be in school on the morning of Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> November.

**YOUR CHILD'S ANNUAL FLU VACCINATION 2022-2023 (LAIV NASAL SPRAY)**

This vaccination is recommended to help protect your child against flu. Flu can be an unpleasant illness and can cause serious complications. Vaccinating your child will also help protect more vulnerable family and friends by preventing the spread of flu. There may be a rebound in flu levels this coming winter following low levels in the past two years as a result of COVID-19 restrictions. The vaccination is free and is a quick, simple, painless spray up the nose.
