Food and toiletry donations received go toward food parcels made up for young people. Please ensure that anything donated is non-perishable and still in date.

### **School Admissions – September 2020**

**Primary Applications** – If your child was born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2015 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2016, you must apply for a Primary School Foundation Stage place for September 2020. Closing date for applications – 15<sup>th</sup> January 2020.

**Secondary Applications** – If your child is in the final year of primary education (Year 6), you must apply for a Secondary School Year 7 place for September 2020. Closing date for applications – 31<sup>st</sup> October 2019.
