NEW PERFORMING ARTS CLUB AT HAWES SIDE

Dear Parents/Guardians

I am very pleased to inform you that a brand new Performing Arts after school club will be starting this coming Monday (14th). The club will run every Monday from 3.20-4.30pm. The children will receive professional tuition in a variety of skills such as acting, singing, improvisation, speaking, mime and musical theatre. There will be a performance for the school and families at the end of the term.

I am a fully qualified and registered teacher and have been teaching for 28 years. I am currently working in a range of schools in Blackpool and the Fylde. I hold an enhanced DBS and am also affiliated to LAMDA (London Academy of Music and Dramatic Art). I am the Director of The Emily Laws School of Acting in St. Annes.

The club will be limited to 28 places so it is important to book early if you are interested. The cost for the first half-term will be just £17.50 (5 weeks). This low charge of £3.50 per session is an initial offer for the first term. If the club continues in the summer term the charge will be £4.50 per session. This fee is due on or before the 14th.
