On Monday we begin our new approach to the teaching of English (Success for All) which we are all very excited about. A great deal of work has gone into staff training and organising 'stage not age' groups and this will represent a change to the way English is currently taught. The children will move into groups across their key stage for 90 minutes each day and we are confident that this new system will have a significant impact on the children's learning outcomes. In order for us to get the most out of this programme it is crucial that children are in school by 9.00am as the Success for All lessons will begin each day at 9.05am. The training and trial sessions to date suggest this exciting new approach will be hugely beneficial however, it would be very difficult for children who arrive late to catch up with any lost learning. As previously reported there is further information about Success for All on the website and a parents' workshop is planned for later this term.
