I would like to start today's newsletter with a heartfelt thanks for your overwhelming support during our recent fundraising events - Comic Relief today and our book fair last week.

Comic Relief was a huge success, and we could not have done it without your support. The whole of the academy had a fantastic time participating in the various activities and dressing up in very interesting outfits. Together, we raised an impressive £308.62 that will help transform the lives of many people in need.

The book fair last week was our busiest yet raising £1415 which means that we will receive £849 worth of free books. We were delighted to see so many of you attending the event and purchasing books for your children. The funds raised will be used to purchase new books for our class libraries, which will benefit our children for years to come. Your generosity is greatly appreciated.

Some of our Year 3 and 4 children visited Blackpool Zoo this week to use their knowledge of animals and maps to complete some orienteering challenges. Their map reading skills were put to the test as they tried to navigate themselves around the various animal enclosures. Along the way they learned some interesting facts about the animals and were lucky to have a sneaky peek at the new tiger enclosure. The children finished their challenge in record time and didn't even let the wet weather affect their day.



Following on with an animal theme, Gemma, and a few of her friends from the Little Zoo to You joined us in our assemblies this week. She talked to the children about her mobile mini zoo and how she rescues animals in need which range from mini beasts, guinea pigs, rabbits and hedgehogs to name a few.
