#### **Contact details**

Please ensure that all contact details for your child are up to date and that you have a password in place. To update these details please contact the school office either by email <u>admin@hawes-side.co.uk</u>, by telephone 01253 402541 or in person.

#### <u>Uniform</u>

At Hawes Side Academy we take pride in our appearance individually and collectively. Our uniform is part of our identity and it is worn by pupils every day.

From September 2022, we expect all our pupils to wear full school uniform. We thank you in advance for your support with this.

- Red V-neck sweatshirt/cardigan
- Y6 only red school leavers hoodie
- White polo shirt (without tie)
- White shirt and school tie
- Black trousers/shorts/pinafore dress/skirt
- Black socks/tights
- Black, low-heeled sensible shoes should be worn

During the summer girls may wear a red and white checked summer dress.

Please note that for all pupils, trainers (unless PE day) and open toed sandals are not acceptable.

#### Our P.E uniform is as follows:

- Hawes Side Academy 'T' shirt
- Black shorts
- Black pumps / trainers
- School tracksuit (or plain black tracksuit)
- Trainers

Please note that on days where pupils have PE they may come into the academy in their PE uniform. On all other days, full uniform must be worn.

Please ensure all clothing is labelled with your child's full name.

#### **Attendance**

Now that we are living with COVID, our attendance policy has returned to normal.

The government states: 'Pupils need to attend school regularly to benefit from their education. Missing out on lessons leaves children vulnerable to falling behind. Children with poor attendance tend to achieve less in both primary and secondary school.'

- Children at Hawes Side Academy are expected to attend school every day and to be on time. Regular attendance includes children being punctual
- School gates will be open from 8.45am
- Children will be able to enter school between 8.50am and 9.00am
- Any child arriving after 9.00 a.m. must enter the academy via the school office to be signed in
- Registers are taken at 9.00am and are closed at 9.05am, after this time your child will be marked as late.

We ask that where possible, appointments are made outside of the school day.

We thank you in advance for your support with this.

#### **Collection of your child**

On the occasions when the named adults for your child are unable to collect, we ask for safeguarding purposes that you notify the school office as soon as possible. Please also ensure that the adult collecting knows your password so this can be shared with the member of staff dismissing your child at the end of the school day.
