Day 1 – Write a list of ingredients for a happy dream e.g. fairy dust, unicorn horns, sunshine, snowflakes. Think about the things that make you happy. Remember to think about how much of each ingredient you will need e.g. 2 teaspoons of snowflakes.	<u>Lesson 1</u> - Adding a two -digit number and ones. <u>Lesson 2</u> - Adding two -digit numbers and ones with regrouping	transparent, waterproof, absorbent and opaque to describe different materials. Can you find an object at home made from wood, metal, plastic and paper? Use the word mat and your own ideas to describe what the material is like.
Day 2 - Now we have decided what to put in our happy dream we are going to plan how we will make it. Think about each step and draw a picture to show what you will do. Make sure you include all of your ingredients. Day 3 - Today we are going to write our instructions for a 'Happy Dream' potion using our plan. In <u>Design and technology</u> this week we ae going to be investigating fruits from around the world. Can you use your senses to investigate any fruit you have at home? What do they look like? How do they feel? Do they have a smell? What do they taste like? Write some sentences to describe the fruits.




