Day 1: Add two 3-digit numbers- not crossing 10 or 100.

Day 2: Add two 3-digit numbers- crossing 10 or 100

Go through the attached ppt. Make addition calculations using a die, then find the answers using the expanded method. (See slide 7 of the ppt)

Day 3: Subtract a 3-digit number from a 3-digit number- no exchange.

Go through the attached ppt and watch the video up to 2mins 20secs, then complete the calculations on slide 8 (work these out using the expanded method)

Day 4: Subtract a 3-digit number from a 3-digit number- exchange

Go through the attached ppt and watch the video from 2mins 20secs to the end, then complete the calculations on slide 8

Day 5: Estimate answers to calculations
