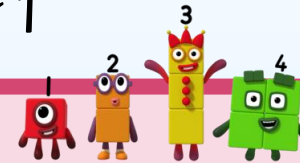


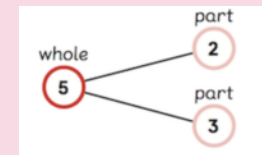
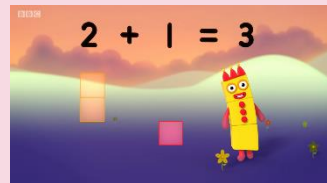
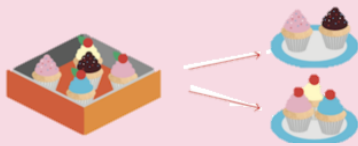
Learning from home – Year 1
