## English

**Task 1** Think about when we described the tiger in 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea'. Can you think of some adjectives to describe the giant? What does he look like? How does he behave? Write a character description of the giant.

**Task 2** Imagine that you are Jack and you are at the top of the beanstalk in the giant's castle. Write a postcard home to mum to tell her about all of the amazing things you have seen and done e.g dazzling, shiny coins, a magnificent castle.
