<p>This week in English we are reading and following instructions.</p> <p>Can you think of some times that you might have to follow instructions? Do you have any examples of instructions in your house? They may be to help you play a game or instructions on how to make a meal.</p> <p>Find a set of instructions and read them with a grown up and see if you can follow them.</p> <p>Have a go at giving a grown up in your house some instructions to follow. You might want to give them instructions to get from one part of your house to another. You could give them instructions on how to draw something. Can you find something made from wood, metal, plastic, glass and rock?</p> <p>In topic this week we are going to look at the work of the artist Carl Warner. He used food to create landscapes.
