English

Reading Week - This week we are reading and learning all about fables. A fable is a short story that teaches a moral lesson and often has talking animal characters.

Day 1 – to predict events.

Listen a fable film e.g. The Lion and the Mouse

<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=yAma4fFC0gI> stop at “this rock is a lion, what a nasty surprise”

Answer the questions:

- Who were the characters?
- Where was the story set?
- What happened?
- Predict what will happen next.

Day 2 – to read a story with expression and fluency

Read the story of the Country and Town Mouse. Read with expression and fluency. Re-tell the story to someone at home. Can you recall all of the events in detail?

Day 3- to read and order story events.

- Watch the BBC Tortoise and the hare video clip: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=bqm0a64j_bY
- Cut out, mix up and rearrange the story cards in the correct order, using your memory of the story events.
- Re-tell the story through role-play.

Day 4 – to identify and discuss new vocabulary. Choose a fable to read. Identify new vocabulary with an adult. Discuss what the words might mean. Complete the word search. Can you create sentences with some of the new vocabulary?

Day 5 – to write a book review

Maths

This week in maths we are continuing to look at addition and subtraction.

Day 1: Subtract a 2-digit number from a 2-digit number- crossing 10.

Begin by watching how to subtract using the expanded layout (not crossing 10)- <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=q-tF7LX7yeo> Then, move onto this video showing subtraction but crossing 10: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WHm8KjpOr98> (from 2mins 50secs) Go through some examples subtracting 2-digit numbers using the expanded layout, focussing on exchanging.

Day 2: Add and subtract 2-digit and 3-digit numbers- not crossing 10 or 100

Go through the attached ppt- Continue to use the expanded method to practise adding or subtracting 2-digit and 3-digit numbers- not crossing 10 or 100 e.g. $536+23=$ $746-35=$

Day 3: Add 2-digit and 3-digit numbers- crossing 10 or 100

Go through the attached ppt and practise the examples on the last slide

Day 4: Subtract a 2-digit number from a 3-digit number- crossing 10 or 100

Go through the attached ppt and practise the examples on the last slide

Day 5: Solve mixed addition and subtraction problems

Go through the saved ppt and complete the worksheet.

Topic

This week in PE we are focusing on dynamic balance and agility. Your tasks are:

- Make different shapes with your body – could you include a family member? Could you take photos to see how well you have done?
- Can you see how far you can jump from a set point. Focus on bending your knees and swinging your arms to help you jump further!
