In Maths we have been learning to subtract numbers by taking away one. Practise knocking down bottles or skittles and counting how many are standing. Allow children to explore subtraction by crossing out objects using pictorial representations. Once they are confident at calculating subtracted numbers children can begin to write number sentences using – and =
