Can you make a Tudor house using craft materials at home?

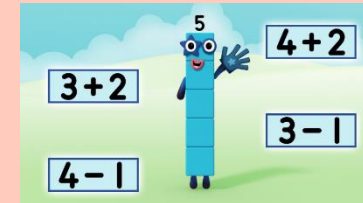


Learning from home – Year 1
