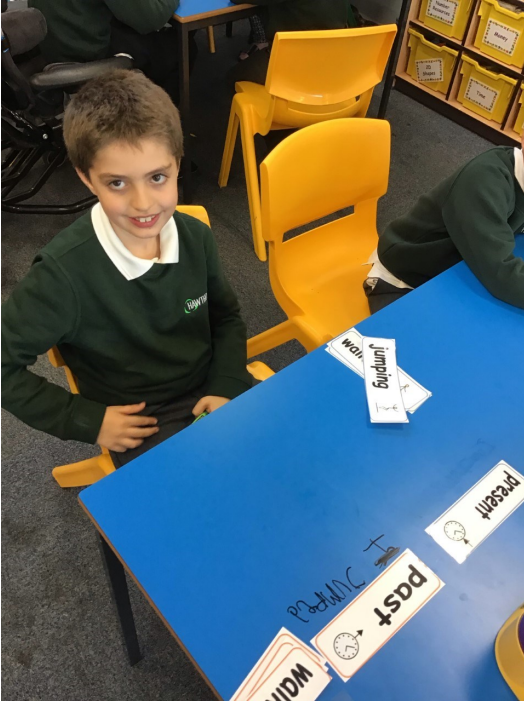
Maths

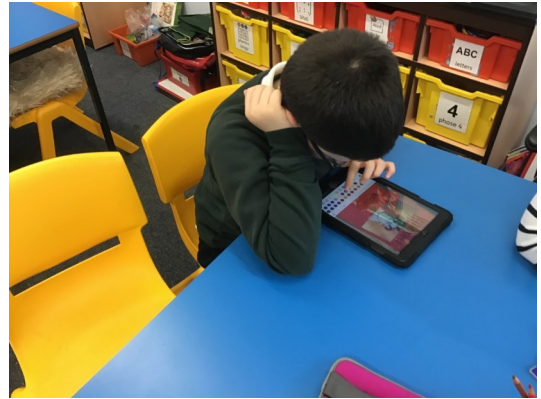
Literacy

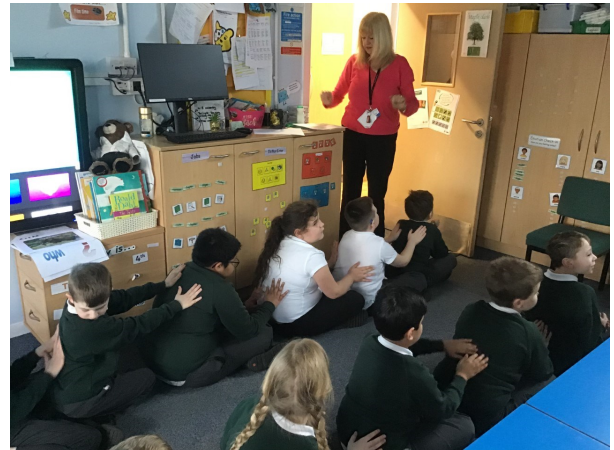
Topic

Out and about



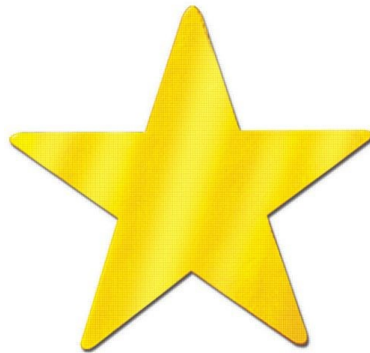
We also go on adventure days and we take part in football competitions.
