### Curriculum Intent:

At Haydon Wick Primary, we have a topic-based knowledge and skills led curriculum.

- Our children are able to explore topics in great depth, ensuring our children have a broad and balanced learning curriculum. We also use the arts to underpin what the children are learning and immerse themselves into the topic they are learning.
