We believe this homework enriches our children allowing them to gain further knowledge of the topics in school. We expect ALL children to complete at least one of the activities from the pick and mix offer. Children are <u>responsible</u> for making sure that the work they complete at home is consistent to the work we see from the child in class. We want everyone to try their best.
