As the weather is getting warmer and the children play regularly outside, it is important that they are protected from the sun. Ideally, please apply sun cream to your child before they come to school on hot days. The long lasting protection types are recommended. However, if your child is prone to burning and you feel they may need an additional application you may send in a labelled bottle of sun cream.

We also recommend you provide your child with a sun hat/cap and we will encourage children to sit in the shade as required at break-times and drink plenty of water. Please ensure your child has their own labelled water bottle with them every day.

If you would like us to apply sun cream you have provided we will need you to complete a consent form.
