Roots – part of the plant that absorbs water and nutrients from the soil.

Petal – part of the plant that absorbs water and nutrients from the soil.

Seed – part of the plant that absorbs water and nutrients from the soil.

Leaves – part of the plant that uses light from the sun to make food.

Stem – part of the plant that moves the water and nutrients from the roots to the plant and supports the flower.


Trunk – part of the plant that moves the water and nutrients from the roots to the plant and supports the tree.


