# Digital Leaders

# Prefects

Every year a Head Girl, Head Boy and a team of Prefects are chosen by the Senior Leadership Team, following an application and interview process. This year our Prefects are: Alex (Head Girl), Lucas D (Head Boy), Lola (Deputy Head Girl), Daniel (Deputy Head Boy), Isaac, Sam, Millie, Freya, Evie, Ena, Jorgie, Evie and Lacey S.

Since the autumn term, our prefects have been focusing on the 'Recognition Board' by spotting children who are STAR walking (Smiling, walking Tall, Arms by their sides, Respectful to others), going above and beyond, showing kindness etc. The Prefects use their iPads to record the children they have spotted and submit a recognition to Mr Cockcroft. Any child who is spotted will receive a gold star sticker for being a superstar, and then when they return to class their teacher will reward them with Class Dojos.
