This half term, we are covering Science, Geography and Art. Here are some ideas that could spark the children's imagination but please only use these as ideas:

- Learn about different rocks and fossils, and maybe even go fossil hunting!
- Discover the life of Mary Anning and create a fact file about her, including why her discovery was and still is so significant
- Having collected different rocks, experiment with them- what can you discover about the properties of different rocks?
- Explore how fossils are formed and create a set of instructions to explain this process
- Research local coastal areas and explain why they are so famous
- Draw an image of local coastal features, labelling and describing how they form
- Visit local coastal areas and create a collage of pictures that you take
- Practise printing with different objects and note the different shapes and textures they create
- Look at artwork showing different landscapes and create your own picture
