Home Learning Ideas

- Find out about the clothes worn by Ancient Egyptians. You could compare Ancient Egyptians' clothing with modern dress. You could present what you find through pictures, photos, fabric creations or writing
- Design & make a piece of Egyptian jewellery
- Create a map of Ancient Egypt. What is the same and different about the geography of then and now?
- Research and create a family tree of an Egyptian Royal family. You could also create and present your own family tree
- Write a list of 5 questions you would like to ask a person who lived in Ancient Egyptian times
- Create an Ancient Egyptians Rosetta stone and write a message in hieroglyphics
- Create a bar graph showing how long each of the Ancient Egyptians pharaohs reigned
- Find out about Ancient Egyptian farming and create a labelled diagram of it
- Create a quiz to test the class on their knowledge of Ancient Egypt
- Write a diary of a day in the life of a slave or pharaoh
- Make a 3D model of an Ancient Egyptian's pyramid/make a net of a pyramid
- Research how much it would cost to take your family on holiday to Egypt
