- Create a map of Dorset and locate different places you have visited
- Research what food is grown in the United Kingdom and how it is grown
- Grow your own fruits/vegetables at home- what do you need to do to keep them healthy?
- Cook a meal using local, seasonal ingredients and write up the recipe
- Create an Iron Man type character and label his features
