


English

The focus for our reading and writing this half term will be based around winter themed



texts. We will explore a range of beautiful texts to collect high-quality description. We will also learn how to use fronted adverbials to add additional information and interest to our writing as well as how to engage the reader by using speech. We will learn how writers use techniques to develop suspense and practise these in our own chapters.

Later on in the term, we will look at explanation texts, exploring a wonderful book called 'Until I met Dudley'. The children will go on to produce their own explanation text about how they believe Santa's sleigh works.

Try not to learn just the words your child has recorded in their log, research new examples to check and see if they do understand the rule they have learnt. Can they apply it in sentences? Red words are also stuck in spelling logs, please continue to practise these at home and regularly review sets of words to support your child in learning these confidently.

Geography Mountains and Volcanoes

We will begin our geography learning by revising the make-up of planet Earth, looking at the crust and how it is made up of tectonic plates. We will use this knowledge to understand how mountains are formed and discuss the key features of mountains. Finally, towards the end of the half term, we will learn about volcanoes, exploring the different types of volcano and researching and gathering information together.


RE Throughout our RE sessions we will be exploring the key question 'Why do Christians believe Jesus came down to earth?' We will learn and discuss many of the different and traditions that Christians celebrate at this time of year, understanding the

meanings behind these.

Music During our music sessions this half term we will be exploring a wide range of different music including genres such as Pop, Folk and Jazz. be exploring a key question 'How does music connect us with our past?'

In our D.T. learning we will explore electric circuits.



Science

Our focus this half term will be States of Matter. We will start by comparing materials according to their state of matter before exploring how temperature affects different foods. The children will learn about the melting and boiling points of water and investigate the processes of evaporation and condensation, linking these to the water cycle.

French
