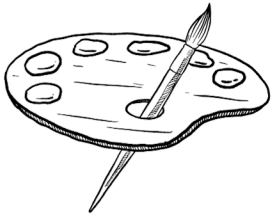

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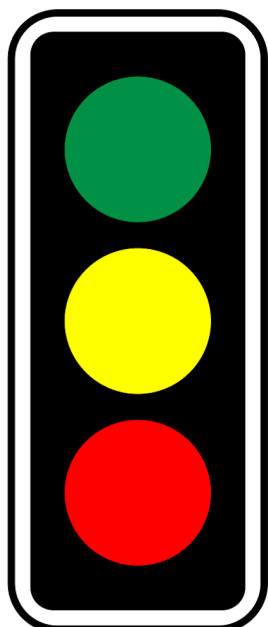
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Reporting Concerns

Lunchtime Behaviour Expectations

I led an assembly on Thursday where I introduced our new lunchtime behaviour code.



We recognise that children can make mistakes. These behaviours are identified as 'green behaviours'. If these occur an adult will speak to the children involved and there may be some 'time out' of playing to resolve any conflict.

Yellow behaviours are where children have an intent to upset another. This could be physically or using unkind words. If this occurs, children will be sent inside to speak with their class teacher. The class teacher will likely speak to parents regarding the incident.

Red behaviours are more serious, such as racism, fighting and swearing. These will be dealt with by Mrs Adcock.

We hope this system will make it clear for both children and adults about the high expectations we have and ensure everyone is following the school's 'RESPECT' code.
