Uniform

As the weather is changing I want to remind you of our Summer Uniform expectations. Children are allowed to wear white polo shirts instead of a shirt and tie. This is far smarter than a shirt without a tie. Boys are welcome to wear shorts and girls are welcome to wear blue gingham school summer dresses. School shoes are still required for safety reasons. 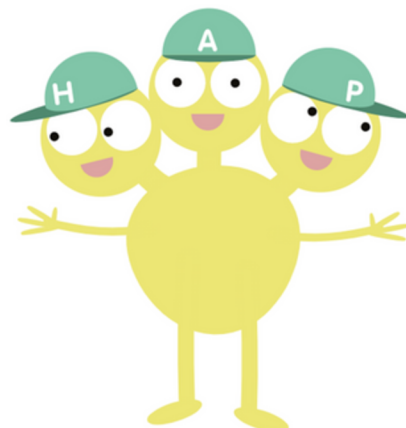
Meet our Happiness heroes team who will be our pupil voice for supporting children's mental health and wellbeing

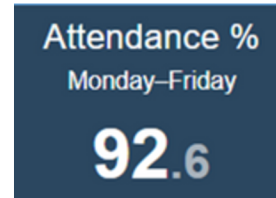
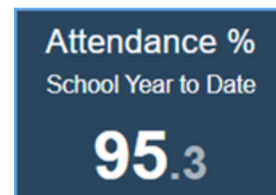
