Our current value is Justice

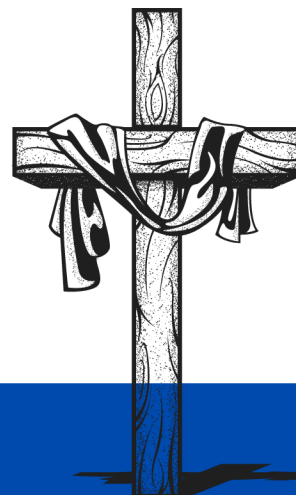
