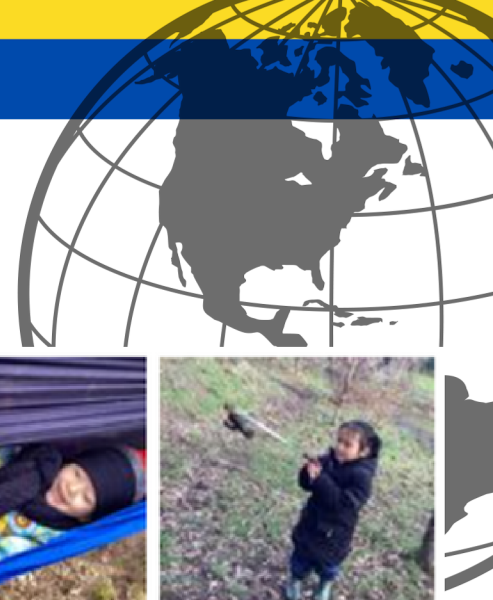
Parents Evening will be held during week commencing 18th March. The booking system will go live this week.
