We are asking that the children wear something yellow and give a donation of £1 via Parentpay.

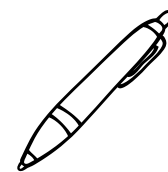

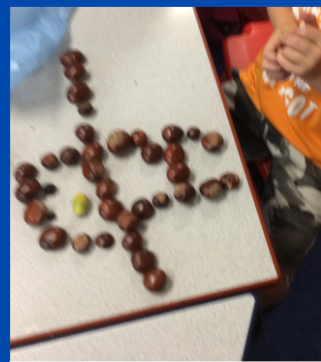
## Nursery and Reception

They gathered materials from around the environment and used these back in the classroom to create people...

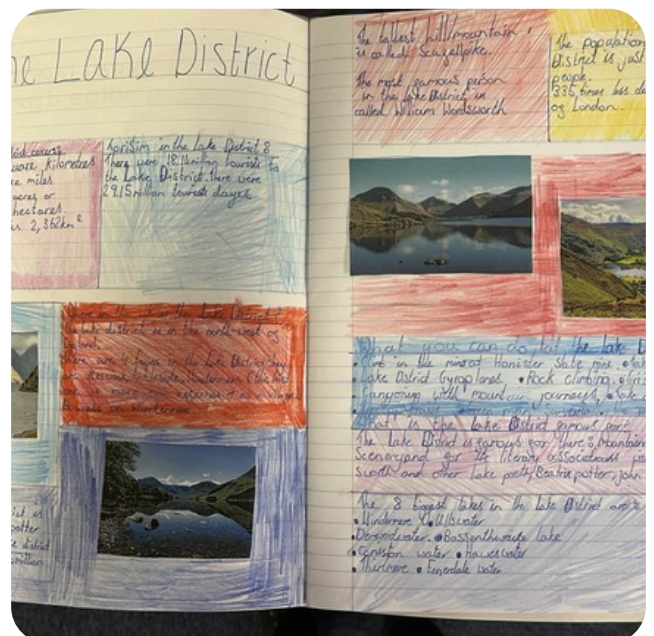
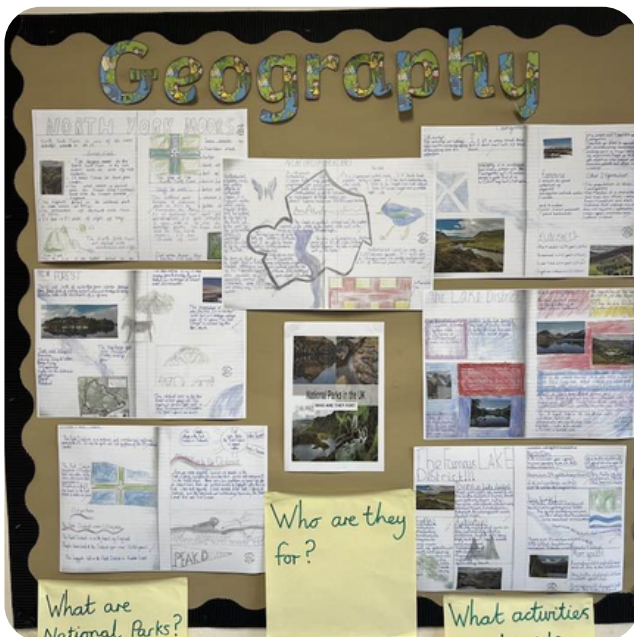


# This Week
