If your child would like to submit a conker towards the conker competition please bring them to me by Wednesday next week.

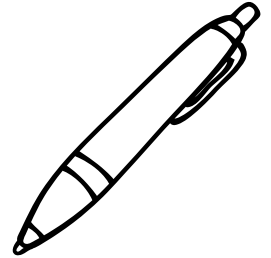

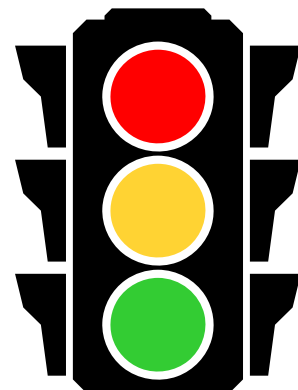
