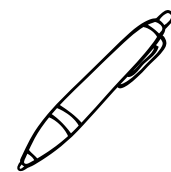

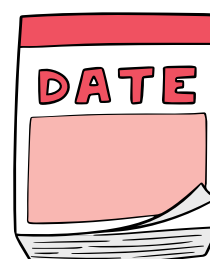

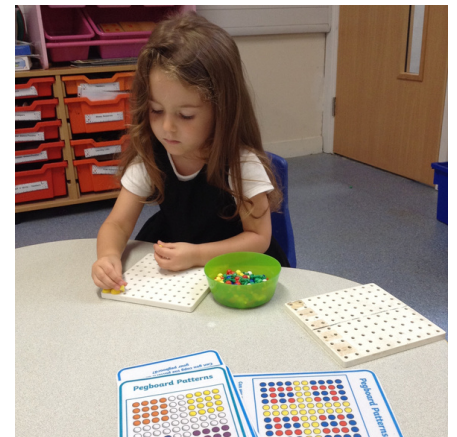

We have loved learning this week.



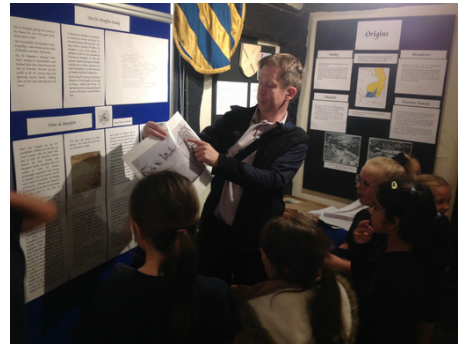
Year 1 and 2 have loved Welly Wednesday.
