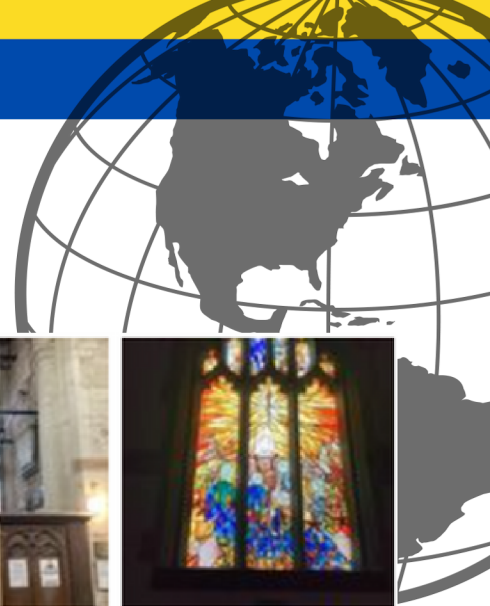
Parents Evening will be held during week commencing 18th March. We will be contacting you to arrange appointments after the half term break.

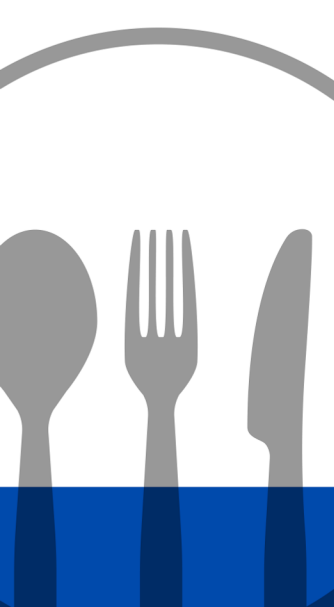
