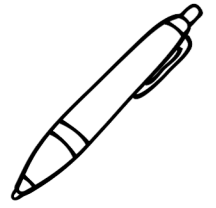
Well done to all children who received a headteachers award. They will have had a golden sticker, had their name added to the 'Golden Book' and received extra play as recognition for being awesome!
