A reminder that from Monday Years 3,4,5 and 6 can walk into school independently and will be collected from the **back playground**.

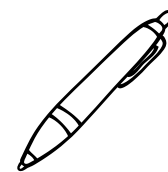
I have loved noticing how smart our children are in their school uniform. Please check that all uniform is clearly labelled and that children are wearing the correct uniform.

We have talked about how we can 'live life to the full' and help others to do the same.

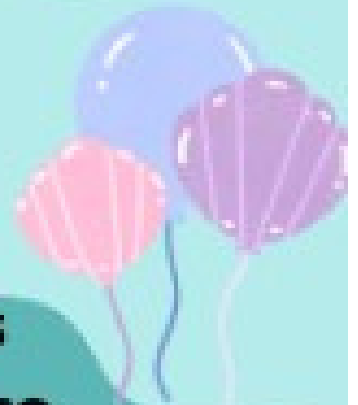
We have also been introduced to our new learning behaviours and considered how these will help us do our best in school! See if your child can tell you about what they mean.

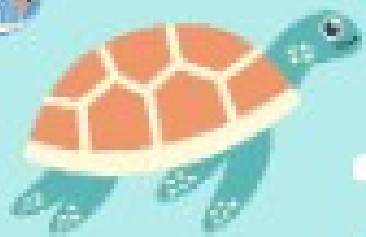

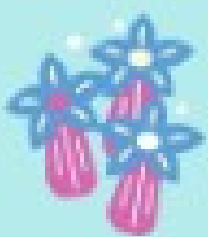
