### **Transition Days and Year 6 events**

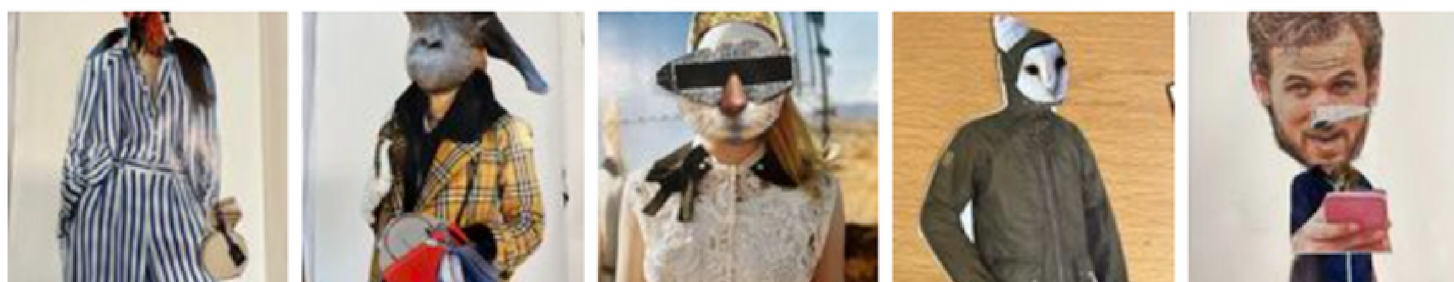
