







Vocabulary (Goldilocks words)

6	stylised	shown in a non-realistic style or way	



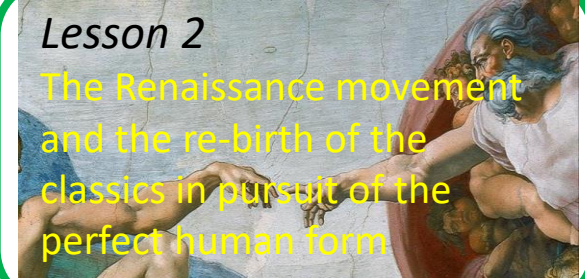

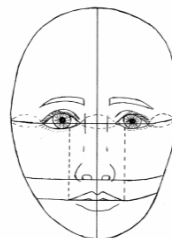

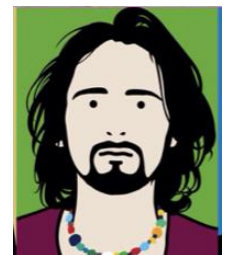
