George in Year 5 sent me this message.

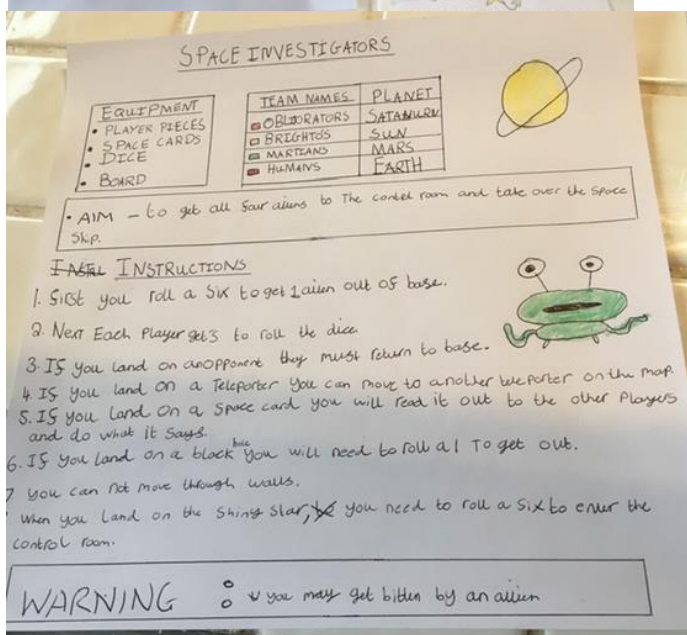
Dear Mrs Hodgson,

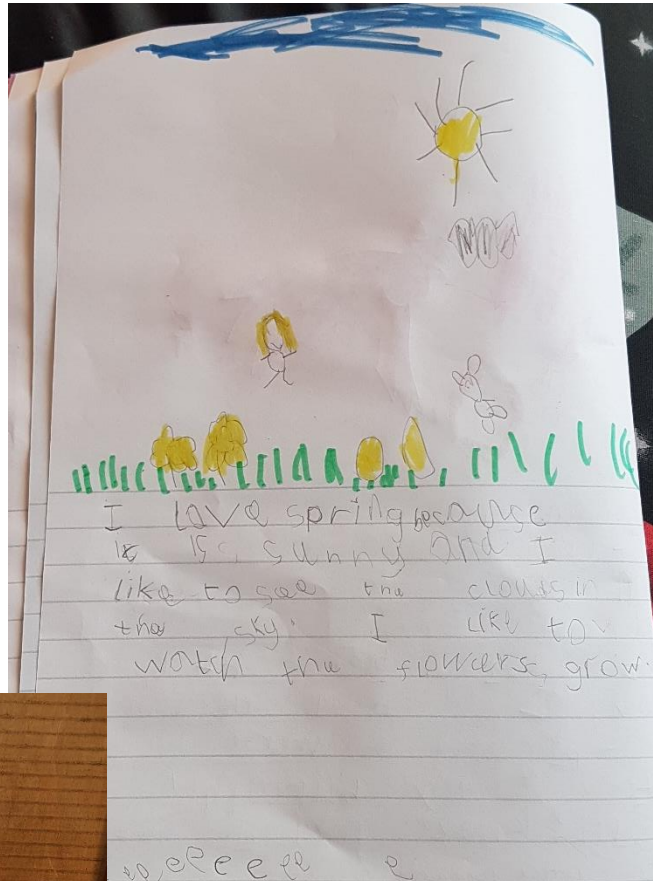
Leo this is a fantastic poster, well done!

I agree completely, this week has been very hard but the Heyhouses team has made it so much better.



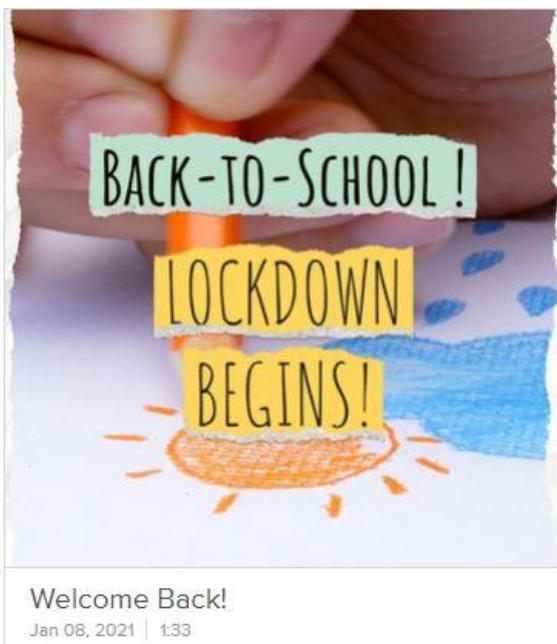
Chloe- well done!
