The Christmas Rescue


The Annual Year 2 Nativity Play is an original script written for Heyhouses called The Christmas Rescue.

It is really important that the pupils at Heyhouses Endowed Church of England Primary School have participated in The Big Ambition survey and had their say.

I want to ensure that the voices of all children in Lancashire are fairly represented in the findings so that I can share their views with the most senior members of the country.

I must reiterate that it is vital that all children have their voice heard through this survey because, as Children's Commissioner for England, I have a statutory duty to protect and promote the views and interests of children. The Big Ambition provides a much-needed opportunity for the children of England to tell political decision makers what is important to them ahead of the General Election. I will be sharing their responses with Government to ensure that children's voices are heard.

Please share the survey and resources with teachers in your school and encourage them to use it in their lessons. Children can complete the survey in assemblies, form times, PSHE or in other lessons this term. The survey can also be done as homework and parents can assist children who cannot complete the survey themselves (children under 5 and children with Special Educational Needs). This is a great opportunity to teach children about politics and why it is important for them to use their voice. Be sure to check out the lesson plans on my website if you want to teach your pupils more about politics before they fill in the survey!

To ensure that our school database is always kept up to date we are introducing a new email address to allow our families to contact the school office directly regarding all matters relating to your child's details that we have on our database. Examples of this type of information are:

- · Change of their school meal pattern
- · Change of medical information.
- · Change of dietary information. For example, any allergies or intolerances that your child might develop or any religious considerations the school needs to be aware of.
- · Change in school permissions regards photos and work being placed on the school website.
- · Change of address and telephone numbers
- · Change in daily pick-up arrangements.

For safeguarding reasons, we do require any changes to your child's details to be made in writing in order for us to action the change, so please utilise this method to ensure we can best meet your child's requirements.

The class email address will still be in place, but these are to be used for direct questions regarding your child's learning not for general information. The email address is enquiries@heyhouses.lancs.sch.uk and is operational with immediate effect.

Please note that all absences MUST still be completed via Parentapps and the school must be informed everyday of your child's absence.






