

The children of Year 5 and 6 will lay the wreath on behalf of former pupils of Heyhouses who gave their lives in the service of their country. This event is obviously open to the public and any parents are warmly welcome to join us at Ashton Gardens.

Any Heyhouses child is welcome to join Mrs Hodgson who will be at St Margaret's as usual on this Sunday and will stand with Heyhouses children in Ashton Gardens. A wreath will be laid to remember past Heyhouses pupils and children who attend will be able to be part of this.
