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This Week

Our book focus has been Each Peach, Pear, Plum By Janet and Allan Alberg. This book looks at a selection of traditional nursery rhymes and the characters from various well known children's stories. We discussed differences with items from long ago featured in the book and what the children's experience of them are. If you have some old household objects at home, perhaps you could look at these with your child and compare them to what we use now.

At the end of the week, we explore the natural environment within our school grounds which we call our 'Wild At Heart' Area. The children also take part in P.E Lessons with Mr Nay, alongside their class teachers. Each class enjoys working on their fundamental skills through taking part in some fun games. Most children have amazed us with how much energy they have left after a busy week at school. We are all ready for a restful weekend!

Phonics

This week's sounds are:



i – inventor - down her body, spot her idea

n - nest - down the bird and over her nest

m - meerkat, mound, mound

d - duck - over his back and around the tail, up his neck and down to his feet

Maths

Focus: Counting, cardinality and ordinality

The children have engaged in activities that draw their attention to the purpose of counting, to find out 'how many' objects there are. The children also explored how all sorts of things can be counted, including sounds.

Home Challenge

Sing counting songs that focus on counting forwards, for example 1,2,3,4,5, Once I caught a fish alive.

Involve your child in counting everyday objects around the home.
