Autumn Term Week 6



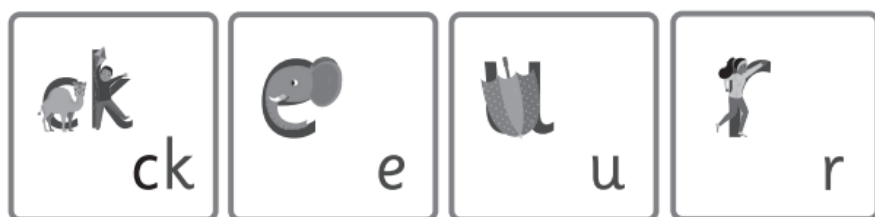
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This Week

Our text's this week have been Autumn themed; *The Little Acorn*, *The Leaf Thief*, *Don't Hog the Hedge* and *The Story Orchestra* which features Vivaldi's *Four Seasons*. Reading these books has allowed us to discuss the changes that each season brings and what the weather can be like. We explored how some animals store food in preparation for when they hibernate in the Winter. The children were given Autumn themed crafts to try which involved using scissors successfully as well as glue sticks and tape dispensers.

We had a visit from the gorgeous baby Iris, Miss Newton's daughter, as part of our R.E Topic, 'I am special'. We talked about how we all begin as babies and then grow and develop. e-elephant- around the head and down the trunk.

u- umbrella- under the umbrella and down to the tip.

r-runner- down her body, up over the arm.

Maths

- count to five in sequence
- count objects of different sizes, count actions and sounds, count objects that cannot be moved (e.g. images)
- count the number of objects and know that the stopping number gives the value
- identify groups of four and five within larger arrangements
