This Week

The children have come back to school full of renewed energy and we have enjoyed listening to their Half Term news. Thank you for sending in some wonderful photos of your Half Term activities.

The focus text was 'Celebrations around the world' a non-fiction book in which the children looked at different reasons for people celebrating. We talked about Halloween and Bonfire Night as well as Diwali, the Hindu Festival of lights. The children shared their own experiences of celebrating these special times and enjoyed hearing stories about the meaning behind these traditions. We experimented with clay to make Diyas, a traditional lamp used for decoration around Diwali, symbolising the victory of light over darkness and the welcoming of prosperity.

Phonics

This was a review week. The children have been reading and writing CVC words.

We continue to read every day with the children at school.

Maths

We have continued to focus on pattern, but with more complex patterns. The children are learning to identify the unit of repeat, which is the smallest part of a pattern, which helps us to know how to continue it.

Lessons have focused on recognising and describing an AABC pattern, building an AABC pattern and correcting an error in a pattern.
