
NEW STARTERS

On Wednesday, 24th September at 7p.m. Bishop Philip, the Bishop of Blackburn is leading a service of Confirmation. All children in Year 6 are invited to be confirmed if they would like to, as part of their journey of faith. Children who have not been baptised may be baptised as well as confirmed on the same occasion. The Confirmation service means the children become full members of the Anglican church and may take Holy Communion at any church, across the world, which is part of the Anglican faith. After seven years at a church school it is a nat-Confirmation ural next step for many of them, there is no requirement for weekly attendance. Please take some time to consid-

er this with your child. A simple signing up form will be sent home on Monday for children and parents to complete.

It is always a very special service and following on from it the children are able to help with each School Eucharist and receive Communion.
