Home Task

The home task requires commitment, effort and enthusiasm.

Tasks which may be used, include:

- Caring for a pet over a long period of time.
- Visiting an elderly relative or neighbour on a regular basis.
- Working towards and achieving a badge at cubs, brownies, guides, scouts, judo etc.
- Following a course of lessons to learn a new skill e.g. Badminton, tennis, swimming, learning a foreign language.
- Helping with younger brothers/sisters on a regular basis.
- Helping at home on a regular basis for a period of five weeks or more.
- Learning a new skill from a parent or friend e.g. sewing, knitting, gardening, cooking, camping etc...

All the tasks need to be a 'new' initiative and demonstrate committed effort over a period of time, at least five weeks. In terms of already established interests such as scouts, brownies, karate etc we would like it to be a new badge or grade that is counted towards this award, not just attendance each week.
